The primary objective is to create awareness regarding the value of education in prevalent times. Other means are also catered to such as creating a platform to enable the deserving to find means of livelihood along with other daily work to set aside savings for the future studies of the child.

Educational assistance is rendered to the sponsored children by providing school fees, tuition fees, smart class fees, special development fees, computer fees together with uniforms, bags, books, shoes and other stationery items which are needed for their education.
